Abstract: This document is a guide to produce the final camera-ready manuscript of a paper to be submitted to DICOMO2016, using Japanese L^AT_EX and special style files. Since the document itself is produced with the style files, it will help you to refer its source file which is distributed with the style files. These style files are based on the style files for IPSJ Journal and Transactions (available on <http://www.ipsj.or.jp/english/jip/submit/style.html>), so please refer them to get more information about L^AT_EX commands, etc. **In addition, please use not the format indicated to the above mentioned manuscript writing guidance but this format.**

1. Paper Formatting

There is no restriction on the number of pages. Submitted papers with full-paper style may be promoted for IPSJ journal. You can see IPSJ Journal style guide in the following URL[1].

- Please do not make biography section.
