1. Paper Formatting

There is no restriction on the number of pages. Submitted papers with full-paper style may be promoted for IPSJ journal. You can see IPSJ Journal style guide in the following URL[1]. http://www.ipsj.or.jp/english/jip/submit/ronbun_e_prms.html Based on the above guideline, this format is customized for DICOMO2016 to suppress output of IPSJ-style header/footer and keep integrity with LaTeX based format.
